Critical facilities, dams, bridges and evacuation routes were provided by the Town of Seabrook with assistance from NHDOT for bridges and NHDES for dams. Information was gathered to accompany the development of a Hazard Mitigation Plan under the guidance and funding of the NH Bureau of Emergency Management. Not every item in the Critical Facilities legend appears on the map.

Base data (town boundaries, hydrography, roads, and utilities) are taken from the USGS Digital Line Graph data, 1:24,000, as archived in the GRANIT database at Complex Systems Research Center, Institute for the study of Earth, Oceans and Space, University of New Hampshire, Durham, NH; 1992-1999. Roads have been updated from work done by the Rockingham Planning Commission and NH Department of Transportation. Partial updates have been completed through 2000.
