

PWAAB River Access Inventory

Plan of action: Divide the 27 identified rivers into logical geographical groupings, divide up groupings among PWAAB members for review of identified access points using available print and web based information, with "ground proofing" of the access points being the ultimate goal. Of particular importance will be identifying and defining the type of access, i.e maintained ramp, vs. dirt ramp, vs. car top... as well as signage and ease of access from public road.

Geographical Groupings:

- 1) **Northern**
Androskoggin, Connecticut (*Map 1, Pittsburg to Bath*)
- 2) **White Mountains**
Ammonoosuc, Upper Ammonoosuc, Baker, Bearcamp, Pemigewasset, Saco, Swift, Connecticut (*Map 2, Monroe to Claremont*)
- 3) **Lakes Region**
Pemigewasset, Winnepesaukee
- 4) **Central**
Merrimack, Isinglass, Piscataquog, Soucook, Suncook, Contoocook
- 5) **Sunapee**
Mascoma, Sugar, central portions of Connecticut (*Map 2, Monroe to Claremont*)
- 6) **Seacoast**
Bellamy, Coheco, Excter, Lamprey, Piscataqua, Salmon Falls, Oyster River
- 7) **Southwestern**
Ashuelot, Cold, Connecticut (*Map 3, Plainfield to Winchester*), Nashua
